Commercials and ads glamorize and promote many products that can be harmful to our young people. One such product is vaping. What is vaping? Vape or e-cigarette is a device that simulates tobacco smoking. It has a atomizer, a tank or cartridge filled with liquid, a battery as a power source. The person inhales vapor instead of smoke. It has been advertised that vaping is safer than smoking. The tobacco industry have lured our young people with flavors such as cotton candy, watermelon, buttered popcorn to name a few, which sounds appealing so they will try the product.

Studies have shown that vaping is harmful and at the time, the long-term effect is not known. Let's talk about some facts:

- E-cigarettes contain ingredients that are addictive.
- The brain is in the development stage until the age 25.

  Many e-cigarettes contain nicotine. In the developing brain the nicotine can make you crave more nicotine. This can affect the memory and concentration.
- Chemicals in the e-cigarette are harmful and inhaling the tiny particles can cause harm to the lungs.
- Adolescence using nicotine may increase the risk of addiction to other drugs.
- Aerosol used in vaping can be harmful to the lungs. Some
  of the flavors are not safe to inhale.
- Defective batteries have caused fires and explosions

Talk to the young persons in your life about vaping. Allow them to talk and give them a safe space to tell you if they have indeed tried vaping. Talk about the effects of vaping so they can understand the facts. It's important for us to be aware of trends and peer pressure that our young people face on a day to day basis. Teach them, listen to them, but most of all love them.
